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A special programme on the occasion of Guru Purnima was organised in the Library hall of Bhavna Trust College on 27th July 2019 in cooperation with the NSS Department.

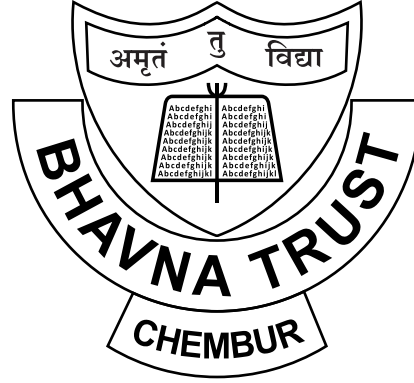

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EDITORIAL

The trustees of Sarvodaya Samaj established Sarvodaya Vidyalaya in 1969, which was the first private Gujarati Medium School in Chembur. To begin with, the School did not have its own building and was started with classrooms provided by **Swami Vivekananda School** at Chembur. Next year it was shifted to a building at 11th Road in Chembur and two years later to the Present premise in a huge building on a Land belonging to **Shri Pravinchandra Dwarkadas Dalal**.

Bhavna Trust was established in 1972 with a team of four enthusiastic, education loving and dynamic trustees Late Shri. Gagubhai Tokarshi' Chhadva, Shri. Keshavji Umarshi Chhadva, Shri. Pravinchandra Dwarkadas Dalal and Late Shri Mulji Khiyanshi Nisar. In 1973-74 Bhavna Trust took over the management of "**Sarvodaya Vidyalaya**" from Sarvodaya Samaj' As a first step, it Purchased the premises for the school. The trustees appealed to their friends for donations for the school building' Response was extremely good. In December 1974, the school building was started. Trustees gave personal attention to the building work with full dedication and self sacrifice' Essential facilities have been provided in the school. The staff, students and parents co-operated a lot and bore all hardships along with the trustees during the transit phase.

The school and College is managed through the school committee and college committee that keeps in mind the basic aims and objectives of the trust and follows department rules and regulations while running the school and college. Admissions

are given to all pupils making no distinctions of caste, creed and religion. Donations are not raised from the Pupils for admissions or any other purpose at any stages.

As time passed by, there was growing demand from Parents and well wishers for an English Medium School. In response to this, **Bhavna Trust** set up **Sarvodaya Vidyalaya** English Medium in 1980 with a K.G. Class. Thereafter every Year as a natural growth an additional standard was added in 1992, the first batch of English Medium students appeared for S.S.C. Exam.

'**Sarvodaya Vidyalaya**' began with hard days. With the support of staff, students (past and present) and well wishers, a paradise has been created at Sarvodaya Vidyalaya.

In 1991 Bhavna Trust has started computer classes to give knowledge of computer to all the students, from standard I to standard X for which an ultra modern computer laboratory was set up with 10 computers. Till today it is running successfully.

In the year 1997 Bhavna Trust obtained a permission to start Junior College of Science & Commerce, which was attached to our Mehta Sarvodaya Vidyalaya Gujarati Medium and it started Junior College of Commerce named Mehta Sarvodaya Junior College of Commerce. This college was started with a view that students who passed S.S.C. from our school need not go in other college and students can take admission in Junior College. This has helped our students a lot because students

of this school, do not have to run from one college to other for admission and do not have to pay any donation.

The ultimate aim of **Bhavna Trust** was to provide education to needy students from Junior KG to Degree. The aim was, a child who takes admission in Junior KG should complete his/her education up to graduation in one premises only. With a view **Bhavna Trust** obtained a permission to open a degree college of B.Sc. (Computer Science) and Degree College of Commerce in the year 2003. It started degree college of of B.Sc (IT) in the Year 2007 and college of B.M.S. in year 2008.

All the parents worry about their children's admission at 3 stages, Junior KG, after Passing S.S.C. in Junior College and after completing Junior College, admission in Degree college. Parents who have undergone the worries at these 3 stages know how difficult it is to get an admission at all the 3 stages. **Bhavna Trust** has come forward and established such a trust amongst parents that now they know that those days are over and they need not worry about the admission of their children. Bhavna Trust knows about the modern technology and by keeping in mind it has started Degree college in computer. Four ultra modern computer labs and AV Room (Audio Vishual) were set up to give better education to students. Library is opened for the students with all the required books available. Advance computer classes have also been opened and for recreation purpose sports gymkhana is also opened. (Bhavna Trust has opened College of Bachelor of Management Science in 2008). Ultra modern Physics, Chemistry & Biology

laboratories are set - up with all the required apparatus.

The college has full fledged security system to face any emergency situation and for the safety of the students and staff we have 72 CCTV cameras covering the entire college premises and class rooms. The college has fire alarms with well equipped fire extinguishers and other fire safety apparatus. The college follows Cashless transactions policy for the admission fees and other receipts as all the admissions from primary, secondary, junior and degree college are made online. The college also follows digital attendance system wherein the students attendance is recorded digitally in every class along with the teachers and periodically the attendance is analysed and after the generation of the defaulters list, the parents of the defaulting students are informed by way of SMS on their mobiles. The college has fully digitized classrooms with well equipped projectors, smartboards, audio visual systems and computers for the digital presentation of educational lessons and lectures.

Apart from the education we encourage other cultural activities in the college such as dance, dramas, music and other activities. To encourage poets and authors, we have started a magazine named **Bhavanankur**. We are sure that management with the help of the students will nourish the Ankur with love and affection that, the Ankur will grow and become such a big tree that it will give fruits, shelter and shadow to one and all.

ARTICLE ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Human rights are moral principles or normal that describes certain standards of human behaviour and are regularly protected as natural and legal rights in municipal and International Law. They are commonly understood as inalienable, fundamental rights to which a person is inherently entitled simply because she or he is a human being and which are inherent in all human beings, regardless of their age, nation of origin, location, language, religion, ethnicity, or any other status. They are applicable everywhere and at every time in the sense of being universal, and they are egalitarian in the sense of being same for everyone. They are regarded as requiring empathy and the rule of law and imposing obligation on person to respect the human rights of others, and it is generally considered that they should not be taken away except as a result of due process based on specific circumstances, for example human rights may include freedom from unlawful imprisonment, torture and execution.

STAND UP FOR HUMAN RIGHTS

1. **Free and Equal:** All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights. They are endowed with reason and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood.
2. **Freedom from discrimination:** Everyone is entitled to all the rights and freedoms set forth in this declaration, without distinction of any kind, such as race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth, or other status. Furthermore no distinction shall be made on the basis of political, judicial or international status of the country or territory to which a person belongs, whether it be independent, trust, non-self governing under any other limitation of sovereignty.
3. **Right Life:** Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person.
4. **Freedom from slavery:** No one shall be held in slavery, slavery and the slave trade shall be prohibited in all their forms.
5. **Freedom from torture:** No one has the right to torture you. None shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or regarding treatment or punishment.
6. **Right to Recognition before the law:** Everyone has the right to recognition everywhere as a person before the law.
7. **Right to equality before the law:** All are equal before the law and are entitled without any discrimination to equal protection of the law. All are entitled to equal protection against any discrimination in violation of this declaration and against any incitement to such discrimination.
8. **Right to access to justice:** Everyone has the right to an effective remedy by the competent national tribunals for acts violating the fundamental rights granted him by the constitution or by law.
9. **Right to a fair trial:** Everyone is entitled in full equality to a fair and public hearing by an independent and impartial tribunal in the determination of his right and obligation and of any criminal charges against him.
10. **Right to presumption and innocence:** No one shall be held guilty of any penal offence on account of any act or omission which didn't constitute a penal offence under national or international law. At this time when it was committed nor shall a heavier penalty be imposed than the one that was applicable at the time of panel of offence was committed.

૧૦ માં ધોરણ નું સતત ૧૦ વર્ષ થી ૧૦૦ પરિણામ ડીગ્રી કોલેજ નું ૮૬ પરિણામ એ વાત ને સાબીત કરે છે કે સંસ્થા શૈક્ષણિક ક્ષેત્રે બહુજ વખાણ વાલાયક કામ કરી રહી છે.

સમાજ નો વર્ગ જે આર્થિક દૃષ્ટીએ દુબળો છે અને અશિક્ષીત છે એના બાળકો મોટે ભાગે આ શાળા માં અને કોલેજ માં પ્રવેશ મળવે છે એનું મુખ્ય કારણ એ છેકે આ સંસ્થા કે.જી. થી લઈ ને ડીગ્રી કોલેજ સુધી કોઈ પણ પ્રકારનું ડોનેશન નથી લેતી, અને એની માસીક ફી બીજી બધી શાળા કરતાં પ્રમાણમાં બહુજ ઓછી છે સંસ્થા નું શરૂઆતથી જ એક જ ધ્યેય રહ્યું છે જે વિદ્યાર્થી / વિદ્યાર્થીની ને બીજી શાળામાં પ્રવેશ નથી મળતો એવા બધાજ વિદ્યાર્થી / વિદ્યાર્થીની ને સંસ્થાએ શિક્ષણ, એમના ભવિષ્ય ને યોગ્ય દીશા આપી અને સમાજ ને અને દેશ ને એક જવાબદાર નાગરીક આપવો.

સંસ્થાએ કોઈની સાથે સરખામણી નથી કરવી પણ એક એવો વિચાર જરૂર આવે કે આજે મોટા મોટા ઉદ્યોગ સમૂહ શાળા શરૂ કરી છે અને રૂા. ૪ થી ૫ લાખની ફી લે છે અને અમુક વર્ગ એની શાળા માં પ્રવેશ લેવા બહુજ ઈચ્છુક હોય છે અને આટલા પૈસા ખરચવા બાદ પ્રવેશ મળે તો પોતાને ધન્ય સમજે છે આ ઉદ્યોગ સમુહની આર્થિક પરિસ્થિતીની સામાન્ય વ્યક્તિ કલ્પના પણ ન કરી શકે એવો કુબેરનો ભંડાર છે એવા સમુહ આખી શાળા ને મફત શિક્ષણ આપી શકે એમ છે, પણ એમનું ધ્યેય જુદુ છે, ઉદ્દેશ્ય જુદો છે અને ભાવના ટ્રસ્ટ આ ઉદ્યોગ સમુહની કોઈ તોલે આવે એમ નથી એ સંસ્થા વાલીઓ ઉપર આર્થિક બોજ નથી

નાખતો અને નબળા વર્ગનો વિચાર કરે છે. આટલો વિરોધાભાસ શા કારણે હોવો જોઈએ એ એક વિચાર માગી લે છે.

શાળા / કોલેજ ના વિદ્યાર્થી / વિદ્યાર્થીનીને સ્વચ્છ, સુંદર અને પ્રસન્ન વાતાવરણ આપવા સંસ્થાની ઈમારત સોળે શણગાર સજી ને અડીખમ ઉભી છે ફક્ત બાહ્યરૂપ ન શણગારત આંતરીક વિભાગોને અદ્યતન રૂપ આપવામાં આવ્યું છે સંસ્થા જાહેર કરતા ગર્વ અનુભવ છે કે પ્રધાનમંત્રી સ્વચ્છતા યોજના અંતર્ગત જે કાર્યક્રમ ઘડાયો છે એ યોજના અંતર્ગત મ્યુનીસિપલ કાર્પોરેશન, સંસ્થા ને સ્વચ્છ પરીસર અને શૌચાલય માટે નું સર્ટીફિકેટ બહાલ કર્યું છે.

સંસ્થા ફક્ત શિક્ષણ આપવા પુરતું મર્યાદિત ન રહેતા રમતગમત ને પ્રોત્સાહન આપે છે એના કારણે સંસ્થાના વિદ્યાર્થીઓ એ આ વર્ષે વાડ સ્તરીય અને જીલ્લા સ્તરીય રમતગમતની સ્પર્ધા માં ભાગ લઈ પ્રથમ શ્રેણીના ઈનામો મેળવ્યા છે.

સંસ્થા બાળકોમાં રહેલા સુપ્ત ગુણોને બહાર લાવવા સંગીત, સાહીત્ય, નાટક અભીનય ના ક્ષેત્ર વિદ્યાર્થીઓ પાસે લેખ, કવીતા લખાવી વાર્ષિક અંક પ્રકાશિત કરે છે અને સંગીત અને નાટક નું વાર્ષિક સમ્મેલન યોજી, વિદ્યાર્થીઓ દ્વારા કાર્યક્રમ કરાવે છે.

સતત પરીવર્તન ના યુગ માં, સંસ્થા આધુનિક યુગ સાથે કદમ થી કદમ મીલાવી ચાલીને સમાજ, રાજ્ય અને દેશ ને આગળ ધપાવવા કટીબદ્ધ છે.

સંસ્થાએ અંગ્રેજી માધ્યમિક શાળા ને તંત્રવિજ્ઞાન સાથે કદમ થી કદમ મેળવીને અદ્યતન રૂપ આપ્યું છે શાળાના દરેક વર્ગમાં પ્રોજેક્ટર અને કમ્પ્યુટર ની વ્યવસ્થા કરી વિદ્યાર્થીઓને શાળાના વિષયો પ્રોજેક્ટર અને કમ્પ્યુટરથી શિખવાડવામાં આવે છે. કહેવાય છે કે આંખે જોયેલું તરતજ મગજ અને મનમાં વસી જાય. પ્રોજેક્ટરથી દર્શાવયેલા પાઠ્યપુસ્તકના વિષયો અને ત્યારબાદ એ બાબત આપેલી સમજણ વિદ્યાર્થીઓ ને ખુબ જ ઉપયોગી થઈ છે.

ડીગ્રી કોલેજમાં એન.એસ.એસ. (નેશનલ સોસીયલ સર્વિસ) ની ગતિવિધી કોલેજ ના વિદ્યાર્થી / વિદ્યાર્થીની પાસે શરૂ કરવામાં આવી છે. આયોજક અંતર્ગત કોલેજના અંદાજે ત્રીસ વિદ્યાર્થી / વિદ્યાર્થીની દર વર્ષે દુંદરે અને આસપાસ ના ગામમાં જઈ દસ દિવસનો કેમ્પ કરે છે. આ કેમ્પ દરમિયાન ગામમાં રસ્તાનું બાંધકામ અથવા તો સમારકામ કરવું, નાના પાણીના બાંધ બાંધવા, ગામ માં સ્વચ્છતા કરી આપવી, પર્યાવરણ ની સમજ આપવી. પથનાટ્ય દ્વારા સ્ત્રીભૂષા હત્યા, નારી શક્તિ, બેટી બચાવ બેટી પઢાવ, પ્લાસ્ટીક બંદી, દારૂબંદી આ વિષયોની સમજ આપી ગ્રામજનોમાં આ બાબત જાગરૂકતા લાવવી આ વર્ષે આ કેમ્પ તા. ૪-૨-૨૦૨૦ થી ૧૪-૨-૨૦૨૦ સુધીનો હતો. કેમ્પનુ આ ત્રીજુ વર્ષ હતુ બે અધ્યાપકો માર્ગદર્શન આપવા એમની સાથે કેમ્પના રહે છે. ત્યાં ચા, નાસ્તો, રસોઈ વિદ્યાર્થીઓ પોતેજ બનાવી લે છે. દુંદરે ગામ કોલેજે દત્તક લીધું છે. કોલેજ મુંબઈ યુનિવર્સિટીનો ડીપાર્ટમેન્ટ ઓફ લાઈફ લોન્ગ લર્નિંગ એન્ડ એક્સન્ટશન નો પ્રોગ્રામ પણ અપનાવ્યો છે. આ પ્રોગ્રામ નો ઉદ્દેશ છે. જેની પાસે કાંઈ પહોંચતું નથી. એની પાસ પોહચવું છે.

सन.१९८९ भावना ट्रस्ट संचलित श्री. एल.व्ही.ए सर्वोदय विद्यालय इंग्रजी माध्यम श्रीमती मीना जयंत भावसार मॅडम शिक्षिका म्हणून रुजू झाल्या, आणि खऱ्या अर्थाने सदर वास्तुस परीस स्पर्श झाला. आपल्या विषयात पारंगत आणि दूरदृष्टी सतत काहीतरी करण्याचा ध्यास आणि सामाजिक बांधिलकीची जाण हे काही त्यांना स्वस्थ बसू देत नव्हते. त्यांनी थोड्याच कालावधीतच आपल्या कर्तृत्व शैलीने सर्वानाच प्रभावित केले.

त्यांच्या मनात संस्थेसाठी काहीतरी करायचे ही अफाट इच्छाशक्ती आणि मग सुरु झाला ध्येयप्राप्तीचा खडतर प्रवास. ध्येय होते जुनिअर कॉलेज सुरु करण्याचे आणि मग तो प्रस्ताव आधी शिक्षण विभाग मग शिक्षण संचालक यांचे कार्यालय, मंत्रालय असा पाठपुरावा दिवस दिवसभर सदर कार्यालयात ठिय्या मांडून बसणे आणि काम मार्गी लावणे यात त्यांचा हातखंडा कधी ऊन, पाऊस याचा विचार केला नाही आणि या प्रचंड मेहनतीला यश मिळाले सन १९९८ मध्ये ज्युनियर कॉलेज सुरु झाले. पण यावर त्या समाधानी नव्हत्या त्यांचे ध्येय मोठे होते. आणि सुरु झाला नवा प्रवास पुन्हा तीच जिद्द तीच अफाट मेहनत ह्यावेळेस मुंबई विद्यापीठ आणि सन २००३-२००४ मध्ये डिग्री कॉलेजची परवानगी आणली आणि कॉमर्स बी.कॉम व बी.एस.सी. कॉम्प्युटर अभ्यासक्रम सुरु केले. आता पुढे काय सतत हाच विचार मग ज्युनियर कॉलेज सायन्स शाखा सुरु केली. तेवढ्यावर थांबून चालणार नव्हते त्याचवर्षी डिग्री कॉलेज बी. एस. सी. (आय. टी) अभ्यासक्रम सुरु केला अजूनही स्फूर्ती तीच होती पुढच्या वर्षी कॉमर्स बी. एम. एस. अभ्यासक्रम सुरूकेला. त्यानंतर ज्युनियर कॉलेज कॉमर्स अँड सायन्स या विषयाला (आय, टी) विषय वाढवून घेतला.

सन २००८ शाळेतून सेवानिवृत्त झाल्या पण अफाट कर्तृत्वाच्या जोरावर सगळ्यांच्या मनात आदर निर्माण केला होता. संस्थेने त्यांची कार्यक्षमता पुरेपूर ओळखली होती आणि संस्थेने रचलेल्या पायावर कळस लावण्याचे काम श्रीमती मीना भावसार मॅडम यांनी केले होते याची त्यांना पूर्ण जाणीव होती आणि हा फाफट पसारा आता सांभाळणार कोण? याची जाणीवही त्यांना होती निवृत्ती नंतर श्रीमती मीना भावसार मॅडम यांना संस्थेने शाळा /महाविद्यालय संचालक पदी नेमणूक करून त्यांच्या कार्याचा गौरवच केला.

सर्व काम त्या एकहाती लीलया पेलवत होत्या कोणतेच आव्हान त्यांना मोठे नव्हते कुठल्याली समस्यांचे समाधान झाले नाही असे कधी झालेच नाही. वयाच्या ५८ वर्षां नंतर ही आपल्याला मिळालेल्या पदास योग्य तो न्याय देण्यासाठी त्यांनी चेंबूर कॉम्प्रीहेसिव्ह मधून डी. एस. एम. (डिप्लोमा इन स्कूल मॅनेजमेंट) पूर्ण केले. म्हणजेच शिक्षणाला वय नसते हे तर सिद्ध केलेच पण आपल्या पदासाठी लागणारे ज्ञान पण अवगत केले. त्यानंतर शाळा/महाविद्यालयास धार्मिक अल्पसंख्यांक दर्जा मिळवून देण्यासाठी सलग २ वर्षेअथक परिश्रम घेतले आणि सदर अल्पसंख्यांक प्रमाणपत्र मिळवून दिले.

आपले वाढते वय व आजारपण यांची कधीच तमा न बाळगता अविरत सेवा केली अगदी शेवटच्या दिवशी सुद्धा आणि शेवटच्या श्वासापर्यंत फक्त शाळा/ महाविद्यालयाचीच काळजी. त्यांच्या जाण्याने आमच्या डोक्यावरचे छत्र तर हरवलेच, पण न भरता येणारी पोकळी निर्माण झाली. असे उत्तुंग व्यक्तिमत्व पुन्हा होणे नाही. म्हणजे **न भूतो न भविष्यति** (भूतकाळात झाले नाही व भविष्यात होणारही नाही) असा हा परीस स्पर्श ह्या वास्तूस लागला आणि त्याचे सोने करून गेला. अश्या ह्या उत्तुंग व्यक्तिमत्त्वाला व मायेच्या अथांग सागराला आमच्याकडून भावपूर्ण श्रद्धांजली.

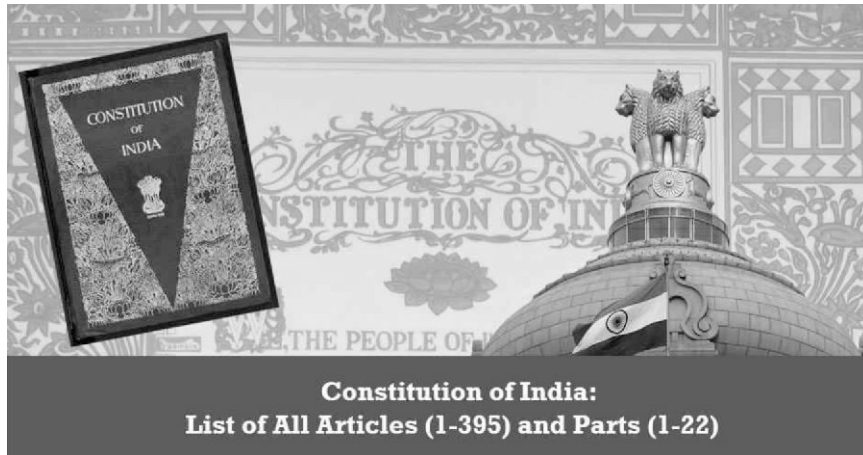

The Constitution of India is the supreme law in India. A constitution is a set of rules and regulations guiding the administration of a country. The Constitution of India is the framework for political principles procedures and power of the governments. It is also the longest constitution in the world with 395 articles 12 schedule (originally it consisted of 395 article arranged under 22 part's and schedules today after many amendments it has 441 article and 12 schedules). The Constitution was written on 26 november 1949 and was made the centre of law in 26 January 1950.

India had to face many problems after independence rehabilitating the refugees who migrated from Pakistan merging the princely state's maintenance of law and order were the major challenges. Sardar Patel successfully achieved the merger of the princely states and province with the union of India. Even the challenge of framing a constitution in the order to enable govern the country was also fulfilled.

The recommendation of the Motilal Nehru committee and the decision taken by the meeting of national congress at Karachi prepared for the formation of constituent assembly.

The meeting new constituent assembly was conducted on 9th of December 1946. The next meeting conducted in 11th of december 1946 under the chairmanship of Dr. Rajendra Prasad participate include Jawaharlal Nehru, Sardar Vallabhbbhai Patel, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and Sarojani Naidu. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Chairman of drafting committee is after called the father of the Indian constitution.

The 389 member of the Constituent assembly formed many committee's to examine in details all the issue relating to the country Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was the chairman of one of the most important committee i.e the drafting committee. Other members of the committee were N Gopala swamy lyengar, Alladi Krishna Swamy etc.

The constituents assembly which came into existence on 11th december 1946 had 145 meeting and framed a draft constitution. During these discussion the various laws proposed by the British government in 1909, 1919 and 1935 the British parliamentary system the American bill of rights the social directive policies of Ireland were studies and some part of those were written in the Constitution finally the Indian constitution was proposed on 26th november 1949 and came into effect on 26th of January 1950. This day (January 26) is celebrated as the republic day in India.

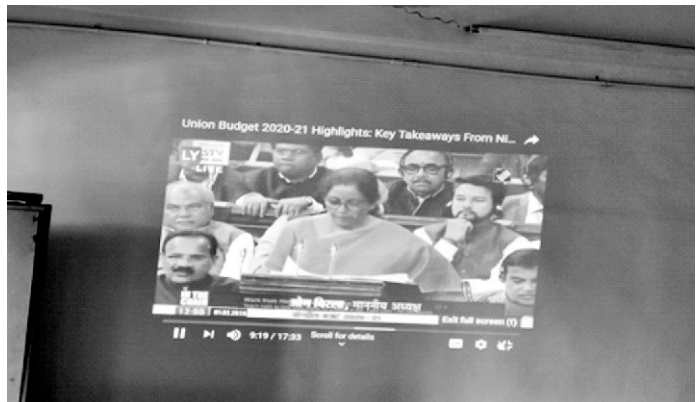

Social media enables users to connect, communicate and share information, photographs, resumes, notes or videos with anyone across the globe. Some of the popular social media platforms are Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, LinkedIn, WhatsApp etc. The penetration of social media is continuously increasing worldwide. The tremendous growth in use of social media platforms/ social networking platforms has provided a fertile ground to cyber criminals to engage in illegal activities. Thus protecting us and our families from becoming cyber crime victims is the need of the hour.

Here are some of important steps which will help to protect yourself and your information while using social media platforms:

- Do not accept friend requests from strangers on social networking sites. Do not trust online users unless you know and can trust them in real life.
- Do not share your personal information such as address, phone number, date of birth etc. on social media. Identity because thieves can easily access and use this information
- Do not share your sensitive personal photographs and videos on social media.
- Immediately inform the social media service provider, if you notice that a fake account has been created by using your personal information.
- Do not share your vacations, travel plans etc. on social media. Criminals can use it as an opportunity for theft etc. Always keep location services turned off on your devices unless necessary.
- Share your photos and videos only with your trusted friends by selecting right privacy settings on social media.
- Always use a strong password by using alphabets in upper case and lower case, numbers and special characters for your social media accounts.
- Do not allow social networking sites to scan your email account to look for your friends and send spam mails to them without your consent or knowledge. **Be Careful While Using Social Media Platforms**
- When chatting with someone online and you feel suspicious about your chat partner, try asking some unrelated scientific or mathematical questions. If it does not answer or acknowledge the question, it may mean that you are chatting with an automated computer bot.
- Do not use public computer/ cyber cafe to access social networking websites, it may be may be infected/ installed with a key logger application which will capture your keystrokes including the login credentials.
- Many social networking sites prompt you to download third-party applications that lets you access more pages. Do not download unverified third-party applications without doing research about its safety.
- Do not hesitate to report, if someone is posting offensive and abusive content on social media.
- Do not share or forward unverified posts / news on social media forums. These may contain fake news or contain sensitive information which may mislead people.

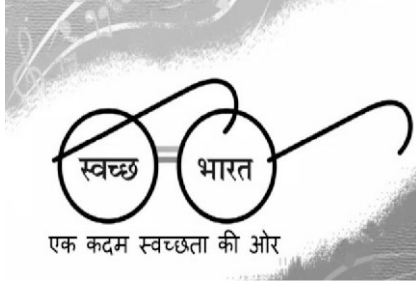
