# **Code of Conduct for Students**

- 7. Avoid gathering or roaming unnecessarily in the corridors.
- 8. Turn off lights and fans when leaving the classroom to save energy.
- 9. Check the notice board regularly to stay updated. Ignorance of notices is not an excuse.
- 10. Sloganeering or disrupting institutional activities is strictly prohibited.
- 11. For long medical absences, submit a doctor's prescription ,Medical certificate and Parents Request letter
- 12. Be punctual and attend classes on time.
- 13. Seek permission before entering or leaving during lectures in emergency.
- 14. Ragging in any form is strictly banned. Violators will face severe action, including rustication.
- 15. Show respect and courtesy to teachers, staff, and fellow-students. Rude behavior will be punished.
- 16. Handle college property carefully. Damage caused will result in fines for individuals or the entire class if unidentified.
- 17. Tobacco use in any form is strictly prohibited and will be penalized.
- 18. Mobile phones and electronic gadgets are not allowed in classrooms, examination halls, libraries, labs, or corridors. Violators will be penalized.
- 19. Dress in a simple and decent manner.
- 20. Carry your library card to issue or return books.
