

By actively promoting and streamlining the admissions process, colleges can attract prospective students and ensure a stable student population for the upcoming academic year.

Other Matters:

During the meeting, several resolutions and decisions were made regarding various aspects of the academic calendar and events at the college. Here is a summary of the resolutions:

- 1. The committee has made the decision to host an orientation program specifically designed for incoming students. The main objective of this program is to introduce the newcomers to the college coordinators, faculty members, and familiarize them with the college's rules and regulations.
- 2. It was determined that all individuals should comply with the previously established decisions regarding the commemoration of national and international days/events according to the academic calendar.
- 3. It was communicated to all faculty members that they are required to maintain a log book (softcopy) which will be checked by the Principal on a weekly basis. This process aims to ensure regular documentation and accountability within the faculty.
- 4. Academic and Extracurricular Engagements: Each department was entrusted with the responsibility of organizing both academic and extracurricular activities for the students.
- 5. Launch of College Magazine: A resolution was unanimously passed to initiate the publication of the college magazine.
- 6. Environmental Conservation Drive: The NSS Unit, in collaboration with all departments, was assigned the task of conducting a Tree Plantation drive to promote environmental conservation.
- 7. Commemoration of International Yoga Day: It was extensively discussed and subsequently resolved to arrange a Yoga event on the occasion of International Yoga Day.
- 8. Significance of Upcoming Dates: It was agreed upon to celebrate the 75th Independence Day on August 15, 2022, Teachers' Day on September 5, 2022, and Republic Day on January 26, 2023, acknowledging their importance in the college calendar.
